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KEYWORDS: abstract, workshop, submission deadline

The abstract should briefly outline the entire study, i.e. concisely state the purpose of the research (motivation), how the problem was studied (methods), the principal findings (results), and what the findings mean (discussion and conclusion). The abstract should be written in English, it should contain one line of keywords, and references should be cited by numbers in brackets, e.g., [1] and [2].

The length of the abstract is limited to one A4 page, using the printed area $170 \text{ mm} \times 240 \text{ mm}$ with 35 mm top margin, 22 mm foot margin, and 20 mm side margins (see also the following page, but do not print borderlines on your manuscript page). As regards spacing and blank lines, please format your abstract such that it looks similar to this page. The abstract should be sent by e-mail to the Secretary of the event, Dr R. Putanowicz, as a LaTeX source file or a PDF-file. Please use the e-mail address: pswcm2013@L5.pk.edu.pl. The abstracts will not be modified by the organizers of the workshops. Please use the Times-Roman letters of the following size:
